## Reflecting on Today's Readings

### What's your burning question?

No matter what age we are, all of us have **one burning question** we'd like to ask God. Are we wrong to ask Jesus questions? **No!** And neither were the Sadducees. It is helpful to ask big questions of Jesus. What matters is that we ask the right ones. Trying to trap Jesus or bargain with Him when we ask a question will get us nowhere. When we have a burning question to put to Him we probably need to remember the several occasions when Jesus said that **the kingdom of heaven belongs to children** (Lk 18; Mt 19; Mk 10). He may have said this knowing that children ask questions keen for an answer. It is that innocence which those of us who are children no more should try and copy. Adults often need to learn from children; to welcome them as the teachers often employed by God to reveal the kingdom of heaven. Whatever age you are, this Sunday at Mass try and identify if there's some burning question you would like Jesus to answer. **Don't be afraid to ask it! Ask it in those daily conversations with Jesus which we should all make time for.** Staring into the heavens, staring at the car in front, or looking outside the kitchen window, can all be moments **when having asked Jesus our burning question we give him time to reply.** He did answer the really long question put to him by the Sadducees. **Let us give Him the opportunity to answer our questions. He still wants to be for us what his heavenly Father sent him to be: our Lord and Saviour and the Teacher of Surprises!** ©

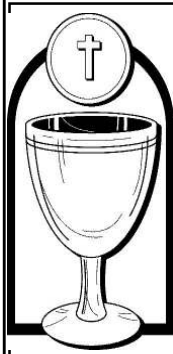

Prayer Requests

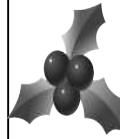
